Important Instructions:

- AD(Stat) of the district **MUST** ensure that **No** Yield Estimation Survey (YES) is missing for any crop, included in the district Jinswar (جنسوار), even a crop is not mentioned in the above list.
- Update your daily harvesting results regularly **only** to the concerned **SO / AD** of the crop at CRS(HQ) as per the attached performa through Phone Call / SMS / WhatsApp.
- For crops grown in lines (e.g. cotton, maize, potato), take width (6ft) side of plot parallel to lines irrespective of field length & width. Stick of the basic corner of the plot **MUST** be nearest to the line.
- For continuous harvesting/picking crops (e.g. fodder, tomato), conduct only **ONE** YES & manage YES program in such a way that different spells (rotations) of a crop may be covered by different CRs.
- Softcopy of **Form:6A** or **Form:6A-1** (for Orchards) **MUST** reach at CRS(HQ) on the due date mentioned above and hard copies later on.
